(as adopted 12 December 1978)

The Human Factors Society, Rocky Mountain Chapter is organized to serve the needs of the human factors profession in the Rocky Mountain area. Its purpose is to promote and advance the understanding of the human factors involved in the design, manufacture, and use of machines, systems, and devices of all kinds through the interchange of knowledge and methodology in the behavioral, biological, and physical sciences.

The Rocky Mountain Chapter is established as an affiliate of the Human Factors Society, Inc., a nonprofit corporation chartered by the State of California, to operate exclusively for charitable, educational, scientific, and literary purposes by authority of and in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation, the By-Laws, and the operating rules of the Society now in force or as hereafter amended.
